



Halifax Regional Health System

- ◆ Serving southern Virginia as a not-for-profit community hospital since 1953
- ◆ With more than 1,250 employees, HRHS provides medical services to thousands, is Halifax County's largest employer and is an economic cornerstone of the region
- ◆ One 192-bed Acute Care Hospital, 3 Long-Term Care facilities comprising 348 beds, Halifax Home Health and Halifax Regional Hospice, and a Physician Hospital Enterprise including 4 primary care practices and 8 specialty practices
- ◆ More than 125-member medical staff representing 28 specialties
- ◆ HRHS has awarded more than \$1.3 million in Project PRIME scholarships and tuition assistance to the community since 2001
- ◆ Halifax Regional Hospital annually provides care to approximately 4,500 admissions, 65,000 outpatient visits, 29,000 Emergency Department visits, and more than 650 home health/hospice admissions
